# Conditions of play

The Championship will be played in accordance with the R & A Rules Limited (Amateur Golf), and the conditions and Handicap rules of the Austrian Golf Association's 2021 (Hard Card) and local rules.

# Eligible

288 Girls and Boys (incl. 12 Wild Cards\*), who are members of an Austrian or foreign affiliated Golf Club and who have at least the following handicaps:

If the entry list is not full after close of entries, the Championship Committee, together with the Tournament Director may allow entries (in the form of Wild Cards) for players with a higher handicap than stated in the original tournament conditions. No application necessary.

If there are more than 276 Entries (excl. 12 Wild Cards\*) higher handicap players will be balloted out. Lots will be drawn if there is a handicap tie. There will be a waiting list.

## Allocation Key and Age Limits

A maximum of 96 Foreign Players (Amateurs and members of an Austrian or foreign affiliated International Association, the above mentioned handicaps) will be accepted to play.

At least one third of the above quota, boys and girls, in each of the above mentioned groups, will be eligible to start. If the group quota is not reached, then the available places will be allotted to another age group. This decision will be taken by the ÖGV Championship Committee and the Tournament Director.

The Austrian Golf Association reserves the right to increase participants (on both courses) to 156 each.

The Austrian Golf Association will award a maximum of 12 Wild Cards, and applications must be received 3 days before close of entries in writing to Sport Director Niki Zitny Niki.Zitny@golf.at

#### CUT

The cut will be determined by the number of players per group.

In principle, 38% of the participants in each group are qualified for the final round, rounded off to the next higher number divisible by 3 plus ties, e.g.: 38 participants of which 38% = 14.4 results in 15 plus ties! The final allocation cut/age group will be made by the Tournament Director after the close of entries and will be announced at the latest together with the starting list on the club notice board.

**Cut for Austrian Players:** Additionally 45% and ties of Austrian players who started in each age group (at least 6 players) must be in the cut, unless they are already in the overall cut!

International Entries

Players without an active membership in an Austrian Golf Club must first register by clicking on the red international entries button and complete all required information. First and Surname, E-mail, Telephone number, Nationality, date of birth, sex, WHI, home Club, Invoice address. After submitting this information, you will receive an e-mail with log in information to enter ÖGV tournaments.

# Telephone, Fax and E-Mail entries are NOT possible

## **Entry Fees**

U10: € 80,-- (includes 1 Practice round, fruit and muesli bar and 1 meal on all tournament days) No discounts for members of the host club.

## **Tournament Scoring**

Girls and Boys will have separate brutto results in each age group

#### Prizes

**Austrian Championships:** Winners in each age group (boys and girls separately) will receive a challenge cup as well as BSO Medals for the first three placements. Only Austrian Nationals can compete for the Austrian Championship Title.

**International Championships:** prizes and medals will be awarded to the winners and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each age group (boys and girls separate)

**Tees:** can be found on the following link <u>www.golf.at</u> and under Turniere/Austrian Juniors Golf Tour, any updates or changes (i.e. course and weather conditions) will be posted here.

#### **Course Rules**

To enable youngsters and children to develop independent play, and to guarantee equal opportunity, accompanying players (i.e. pre-caddy) is not permitted.

Parents, friends, professionals or other spectators are not allowed to give advice or offer help. All decisions to be made regarding the rules, or problems that arise, will be made exclusively by the competition management and the player. Any interference by parents or others will lead to disqualification. **Only authorised Tournament Officials are allowed.** 

Caddies – are not allowed. Parents, companion, trainers or others are not permitted to play on training days without exception.

#### Golf Carts

Golf carts are prohibited on training days. Competitors breaking this rule will be banned from the event.

#### Anti-Doping

By participating in this tournament, the player is obliged to comply with the anti-doping regulations of the 2007 Anti-Doping Law as well as the anti-doping regulations of the ÖGV (in particular their statutes, sport regulations and tournament conditions) and the responsible International Associations.

#### Championship Committee

The competition management is the responsibility of the Austrian Golf Association's Championship Committee The Committee will be nominated by the AGA Championship Committee.

Referees' decisions and the Committee's decisions are final.

Local rules and start times will be displayed on the club notice board.

The Committee reserves the right to amend the conditions of play before start of play.
